Other Charges:

For All Students:

- Caution Money (Refundable) Rs. 10,000/- payable at the time of admission only (approved by HP Govt.)

- Institutional Development Charges Rs. 10,000/- per annum (approved by HP Govt.)
- End Term Examination fee Rs. 600/- per semester (approval in process).

For Hostellers:

- Hostel Caution Money (Refundable) Rs. 5,000/- payable at the time of admission (approved by HP Govt.)
- Hostel Room Rent (Per Annum) Rs.30,000/- (Single occupancy), Rs.24,000/- (Twin sharing), Rs.18,000/- (Triple sharing) payable at the time of admission (approved by HP Govt.)
- Mess Charges Rs. 2500/- per month, Laundry Charges Rs. 300/- per month.
