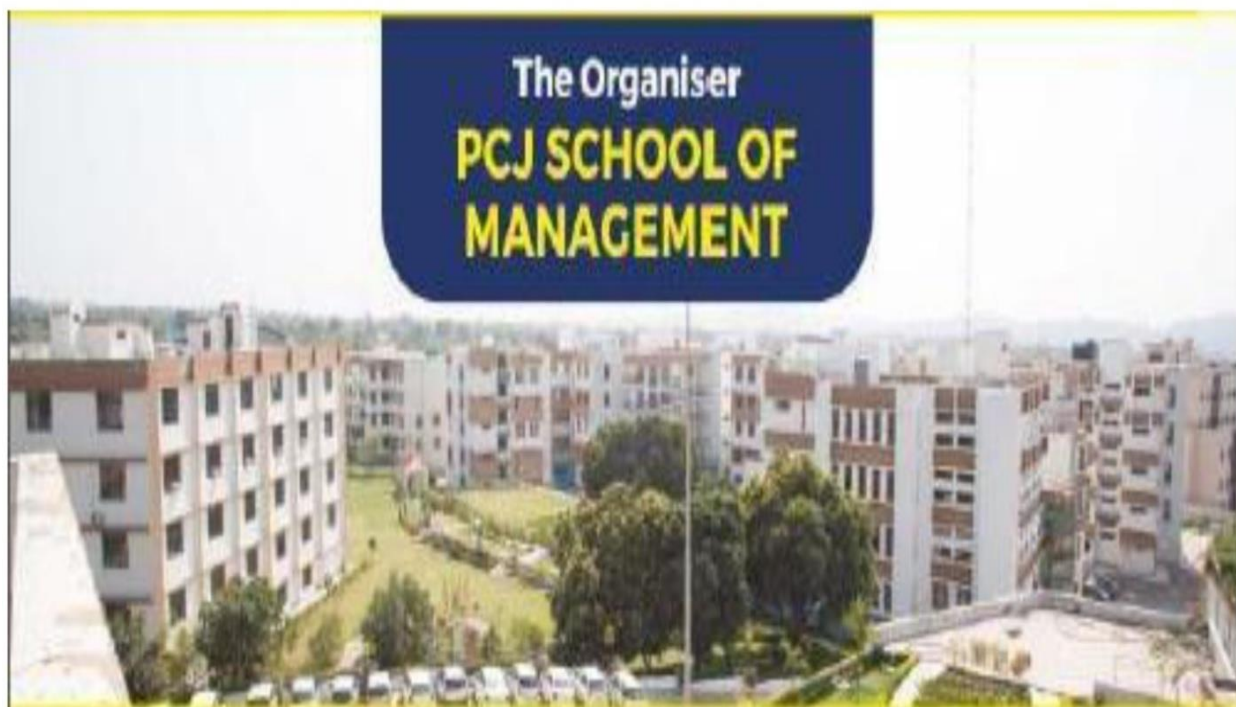
## **ABOUT THE UNIVERSITY**
